Murder Charges Filed as Wounds Are Fatal to Man

DEPT. Aug. 12 — First degree murder charges were filed against David Webb, 50, Negro, Minidoka, Tuesday in connection with the death of Gus Spain, also Negro and 35.

Spain died at 3:40 a. m. Tuesday in the Rupert General hospital as a result of wounds received when shot Friday at Minidoka.

Spain and Webb shared the same cabin at Minidoka where Webb was in the kitchen when the shooting occurred. According to first reports received on Monday the two men had been quarreling over cleaning the mess hall.

Spain had a three-inch cut on his forehead when he was brought to the hospital with a stab wound in his back.

Webb was arrested Saturday afternoon and taken to the hospital.

The shooting Webb was held in the Minidoka county office under a \$5,000 bail on charge. He was to be held before Probable Judge at 10 a. m. Monday.

John R. Woodson of Boise was requested to act as prosecutor in Spain's Tuesday trial.

"Ike" Favors Flexible Help, Kline Reports

DENVER, Aug. 12 (AP) — Allan Kline, president of the American Farm Bureau federation, said today Dwight D. Eisenhower apparently favors a flexible farm price support system rather than rigid price supports.

Kline's organization, the largest of the big farm groups, is on record in favor of flexible price supports.

"I believe that he agreed that the philosophy of agricultural policy of 1849 was a good, sound position."

Law recalled

"The 1849 act provided for a sliding scale of 75 to 90 per cent of parity for price supports on the six basic commodities, corn, wheat, cotton, rice, peanuts and tobacco.

The present law, approved by the Democratic-controlled Congress in 1933, grants price supports for the basic commodities at 90 per cent of parity.

Group Seeks Plan as State Polio Spirals

BOISE, Aug. 12 (AP) — The state polio planner declared today that to postpone declaration of an epidemic because of few cases were not grouped dangerously in any one area and the state has adequate facilities to handle cases already reported.

"It is not only in Idaho but in the entire country that the polio epidemic is spreading rapidly," he said.

Polio cases—three children at Lewiston and an 11-year-old Emmet girl—raised the total polio cases reported in Idaho to 18 today by the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis.

Big Slice Made in Utah School Levy

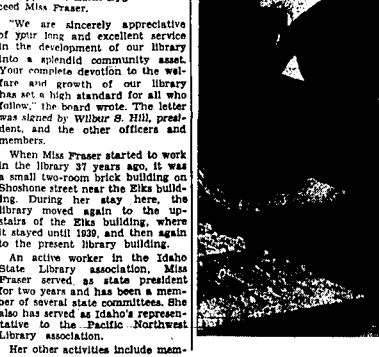
HALT LAKE CITY, Aug. 12 (AP) — The state tax commission sliced the state and local school tax levy 40 per cent under the 1935 finance bill.

This marked one of the largest property tax reductions in Utah history, Commissioner Gordon T. Stevenson said. Officials said the reduction was possible in the face of increasing school costs because of higher prices for state income and corporation taxes.

The site will be about 18-20 miles north of Portsmouth in southern Ohio. It will be on the Scioto river which flows into the Ohio river at Portsmouth.

The boy had been fishing with his mother and younger brother. Water in the canal was turned out immediately but the body was not recovered until 12:45 p. m. Monday.

Rains Boost Outlook for Idaho Crops

BOISE, Aug. 12 (AP) — The rains that fell last night in eastern Idaho; they stopped just when northern Idaho farmers wanted them.

The monthly crop report issued by the U. S. department of agriculture in Washington Monday depicted significant increases in the Idaho farmers' crops of wheat, potatoes, sugar beets, barley and dry beans. Only hops among the major crops looks worse than a month ago.

In its latest measurement of production prospects, the agriculture department reported today that the combined volume of all crops this year will be larger than in any year except 1940 and 1942.

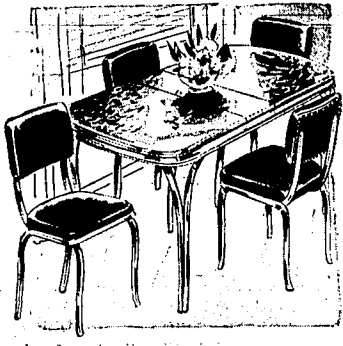
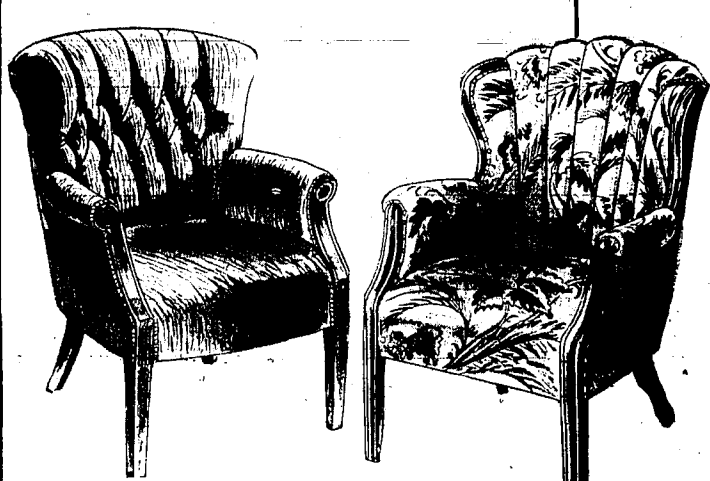

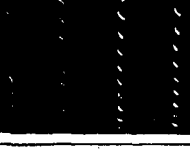

Meanwhile, Shah Mohammed Reza Pahlavi distributed title deeds to peasants who had purchased parts of royal estates on long term small installment plans.

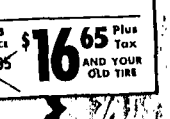

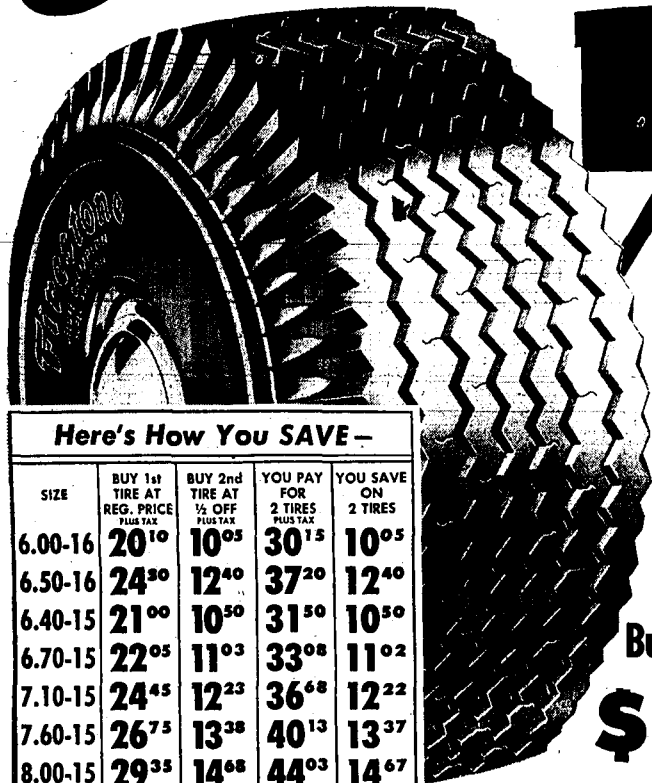
