SENATOR NIXON'S RECORD

SENATOR NIXON'S RECORD

The great surprise in the Republican national convention continues to be the selection of young Sen. Richard M. Nixon of California as vice presidential candidate. He was General Eisenhower's personal choice. But behind that are a number of circumstances requiring fuller explanation.

Benator Nixon was a California detegate and cast his vote for Gov. Earl Warren as the state's favorite-son candidate for the presidency. But throughout the pre-convention maneuvering, Senator Nixon was Eisenhower contact man with the Californians and was influential in trying to get pledges for Eisenhower votes to be cast after the delgation should be released by Governor Warren. Senator Nixon's interest in the Eisenhower movement stemmed from a poli of California Republicans he conducted earlier in the year. To a mailing list numbering over 10,000, Senator Nixon send queries on preferences for presidential candidates. The replies came back overwhelmingly in favor of General Eisenhower, with Benator Taft a poor second and Governor Warren third. That is what supposedly converted Senator Nixon to General Eisenhower—and vice versa.

The publicly announced reasons for Senator Nixon's selection as vice presidential candidate were first, his possible appeal to youth, and second, his calculated appeal to the voters at large as a cleaned-up foe of communism.

As a bright and starry-eyed young progres-sive Republican, however, a careful examina-tion of Senator Nixon's voting record in con-gress reveals his qualifications as a knight in General Eisenhower's new crusade against the old much

the old guard.

On foreign affairs, since he got into the senate two years ago, Nixon has voted pretty consistently in support of the Esenhower point of view. In 1951 he voted against cuts of economic aid to Europe. He also voted against cuts in military aid. He was for the bill on final nessers.

This year he voted five times against cuts in the mutual security program and was for the bill on final passage. He voted to add 22 million doilars to Voice of America funds. He voted to limit U. S. troops in Europe to four divisions. But he voted for universal military training and against limitations on the draft. He voted against cuts in U.S. defense and air force appropriations.

Previously, as a congressman in the lower house, he had voted against aid to Korea and voted for cutting arms aid to Europe. He was absent and unrecorded on the original Point Four bill to give aid to underdeveloped countries. He voted for all the "crippling" amendments to the reciprocal trade agreements to the reciprocal trade agreements passage.

On labor legislation, he voted for the Tattlertley hav, voted for use of this law in the steel strike and voted for shollition of the wage stabilization bound. He voted for the Knowland amendment allowing unemployment compensation funds to be used against atrikers.
