

For instance, regarding the faulty mechanical condition of vehicles, which could be greatly improved by periodic compulsory instance, reports from 25 states indicate that fout 6 per cent of the vehicles involved in Mala accidents had one or more unaafe conditions. About one-third of the defects were unsafe brakes, a sixth were blowouts or other tire defects, and another sixth were improperly adjusted or burned-out lights.

Speeding was the most important driver working the proximately 25 per cent of the fatal-accidents. Approximately 26 per cent of the fatal-accident drivers were soing too fast for afety under the prevailing conditions—traffic, weather, type of road.

In cities, right-of-way violations were second in importance. In the country, it was failure to keep to the right of the center line.

A special study carried out by the states of Connecticut, Massachusetts, Nebraska and Wisconsin showed that young people are by far the most dangerous drivers.

More traffic deaths occur in October than in any other month, with September, November and December also bad. This is despite the fact the peak motor vehicle traffic load occurs in August. The fewest traffic deaths occur in February.




