International Harvester has had increases totaling 50 cents an hour—34 cents in straight wages and 16 cents in fringes.
General Motors has had increases totaling 44½ cents—30½ cents in straight wages and 14 cents in fringes.
The recent steel strike settlement, plus earlier increases, gave steel workers total increases of 37½ cents—32 cents in wages, 5½ cents in fringes.

These figures are cited to indicate that the steel wage settlement did not set a new pattern or a new ceiling for future increases in other industries.

It is within this range of total increases of from 37½ to 50 cents an hour since Jan. 1, 1950, that future wage cases are likely to be settled by the new wage stabilization board. Under its new chairman, Archibald Cox, this new WSB has just started to function. The new defense mobilization act which created this board as a replacement for the old one which tried and failed to settle the steel wage case, operates under much limited authority.

Only the rubber-workers' case is now before the board for approval. But the others may be expected in due course. This is the record of settlements since Jan. 1, 1850, for key companies in those industries:

Goodyear rubber—Total increases to August, 1951, 24½ cents an hour. The increase expected to be approved will be in the neighborhood of 10 cents, making total increases 34½ cents.

Mest-packers—Swift employes granted total increases of 201/2 cents an hour last December—281/2 cents in wages and one cent in
fringes. The unions are demanding a substantial wage increase, guaranteed annual wage,
pensions, health and other fringe benefits
Packing companies, like coal operators, are
pleading inability to pay more out of present
profits.

Electrical industry—General Electric employes given total increases of 20 cents an hour cumulative to September, 1951—25 cents in wages, four cents in fringes. Negotiations for new contracts have been opened, with the unions demanding increases of 20 to 30 cents an hour—12 to 15 cents in wages, the rest in fringes.

Bilpbullding—West coast shipbullders have been granted total increases of 19 cents an hour up to January, 1951—18 cents in wages and one cent in fringes. East coast shipbullders won increases averaging 25 cents in June, 1951, and are demanding 29 cents additional
