

MEANINGLESS PROMISES

MEANINGLESS PROMISES

We may be hearing some pomises one however vague about cuts in income taxes, cuts in government spending. And it would make nice reading. But before buying any such campaign promises—however vague—it might be a good idea to take a look at the glum, gray, but solid figures.

The government this year will spend around 85 to 90 billion dollars. Last year it spent approximately 71 billion.

Of the 85 to 90 billion to be spent this year, about 56 billion will be for defense. And agreed-on and contemplated defense expenditures for the next five years will total at least 250 billion.

The qualification "at least" has significance

The qualification "at least" has significance if only as it covers the revamping of our military forces in line with the latest scientific improvements,

For instance, the B-36 bomber. Only about three years ago that glant alteraft was about the hottest card we held in the international air defense game. Today the B-36 is virtually obsolute.

air defense game. Today the B-30 is virtually obsolete.

It hasn't even been used in Korea, and chances are it will never see combat. Reason: the development of jet bombers by England and other countries. That same development will have to be made by our own air force, and it will cost lots of money.

Then, there's the atomic-powered submarine. We aiready have one near completent, If it's successful, and eventually it almost certainly will be, our whole submarine fleet will have to be revamped atomakes.

How extensively atomic energy will be applied to powering our other machines of war is anybody's guess. But the field seems at this time to be pretty wide open. And the cost of any such wholesale revamping as that is at this time almost incalculable.

The whole broad area of military elec-

is at this time almost incalculable.

The whole broad area of military electronics—radar, sonar, electric aiming and firing devices, and all the rest—are still largely in the development stage. Further improvements are coming along all the time. And they all cost money. Lots of it.

and weapons, estimate we may very well go on paying out at least 50 billion dollars a year for defense for the next 20 years.

And when you stop to think that right now over 62 per cent of our annual expenditures are going for defense, it's pretty hard to sewhere any stable reductions are going to be made—in spending, and consequently in taxes.

There'll be a lot of other promises, too.
There'll be a lot of other promises of less government interference
with business, fewer controls, lower prices
and all those scores of other assurances millions of American people would like to hear.
But these promises will be made largely for

For a moment, all these promises will be music to the ears, but it won't take long for us to snap back to a full realization of all the ugly facts.
