While it's encouraging to note that traffic fatalities in Magic Valleys of ar this year total 25 as compared with 31 deaths in automobile accidents during the same period in 1951, that is no reason for us to be over confident that the end of the year will show any reduction in the total number of lives lost.

We must bear in mind that automobile accidents have not reached their peak for the year once the much publicized fabor day week-end traffic toil is past.


