

"Unless prevented by successful policies, positive as well as defensive, this deterioration could lead, after a few years, to a most serious danger of general war, and even to a situation in which Soviets: relative power had been so augmented by territorial gains or alliances in Europa and Asia-that-they-could-successfully attack the Western hemisphere."

The best thing about the report is that in not only points out world dangers but offers concrete suggestions for combatting them.

On the defensive side it says that continued military programs among the free nations are essential to keep commitme from disrupting "the task of building, the secondit cand political foundations of a free and healthy society ifter and abroad."

But it warned that primary emphasis on military build-up can be "self-defeating."

On the positive side, the report says the main fob of America is to increase its own conomic health and to help other countries to solve their comment and political problems. More specifically, it recommends some form of political union for Europe. Regarding Asis. "There is not of the United States free world, an interest in social and conomic reform in free Asia and fo support that interest with practical action through United Nations' segencies and otherwise."

The report notes that the best foreign propagand at this country could have is "gostive action, which other peoples can "see will serve their purposes as well as our own."

The tone of the report is as temperate as its wording is forthright. If it points out some of our mistakes, it also points a way to avoid future ones. And coming from whom it does, certainly it deserves the attention and the condideration of everyone.


