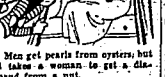

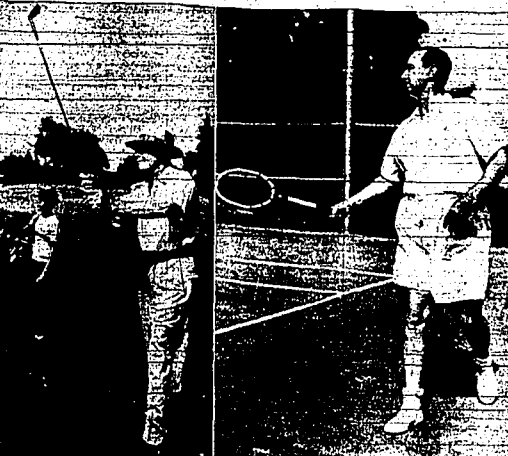

Both Major Presidential Candidates Are in Good Health, Doctors Report

Despite the tension and fatigue of campaigning, both major presidential candidates are in good health, their physicians report.

In a little more than three months Eisenhower or Adlai Stevenson will be inaugurated President. The question of health will loom large, President Truman has said often his was a "killing" job.

Neither candidate has a chronic disease or has been ill recently with a serious infectious ailment. Their doctors report they have no disorders in major organs or bodily functions. Stevenson and Eisenhower both seem to be in good shape emotionally, too.

Dr. Daniel P. Pearson, Springfield, Ill., Stevenson's physician, reported the Democratic presidential candidate has "excellent nervous and emotional stability."

Pearson said once when Stevenson was suffering from "severe pain of kidney colic" he showed no "signs of anguish" and another time finished a speech before a large audience while the pain was present.

Stevenson sleeps about seven and a half hours a night and gets a good rest, having "trained himself to sleep well on trains, in airplanes and in rapid overnight stops."

Stevenson is used to a 10-hour day with few long vacations. Snyder said Eisenhower likes to walk, play tennis or golf and ride.

Eisenhower's blood pressure, pulse and heart are normal, there is no sign of heart or lung abnormality. He has no allergies, chronic ailments, or any record of operations more serious than a tonsillectomy 26 years ago and the removal of the kidney stone by special instruments, without surgery.

According to Snyder, Eisenhower's blood pressure ranges between 120 and 140 systolic and has been noted during his military career as an officer.

Eisenhower, too, is an avid golfer and is not enthusiastic about tennis. He also occasionally exercises in a rowing machine. An excellent bridge player, he prefers sessions at the card table and painting for indoor relaxation.

Stevenson likes discussions with friends to take off tension after a hard day. He also likes to handle the controls of an airplane, Pearson reported.

Stevenson is 5-foot-10-inches tall and Eisenhower is exactly the same height. The Illinois governor now weighs about 185 pounds, or 15 pounds more than he did when he was 26 years old, Pearson said he has a "tendency to become overweight" and therefore "voluntarily restricts fattening foods."

Eisenhower also diets for the same reason. However, he weighs only 176 pounds—or four pounds more than during his football days at West Point, Snyder pointed out, though that Eisenhower's weight "has been as high as 184 within the past two years."

Eisenhower "has had very few vacations during the past 10 years," Snyder reported. Pearson said Stevenson likes about "breaks" away from his side work, but almost never takes long vacations.

Luckily, both men have excellent digestion, an important factor while on the tired children and maddened potatoes trail of a grass roots campaign.
