Two recent events give added shape to the often shadowy form of Russian foreign policy. One was the publication of a new book by Josef Stalin. The other was a conference in

Josef Stalin. The other was a Pepiping, China. In his book, Stalin says the most important his book, Stalin says the war II was the economic result of World war II was the dividing of the world into two markets, one dominated by the United States and the

cividing of the world into two markets, one dominated by the United States and the other by Flussia.

Out of this situation, he says, has developed the twin emergence of West Germany and Japan in United States orbit, both countries so directly competitive they will caus severe conflicts in the Western world. He clies Britain and France as another instance of such competitiveness.

While what Stalin says isn't exactly new, the fact that he places emphasis on it is significant. For, realizing the communistry historic readiness to stir up and asgravate differences among their enemies, there's every reason to expect them to so act in this case.

case.

How they will operate in detail Stalin's book doesn't say, But the conference in Pelping makes pretty certain that action there will be, whatever its nature.

The Pelping meeting—called a peace con-ference—was attended by representatives of more than 30 countries, some of them so small as to be identifiable only on a pretty big

small rarto be identifiable only on a pretty big map.

But the important thing, in the light of sitalin's book, was the emphasis given to the Japanese question. It was the first detailed order of business.

Coincidentally, perhaps, this emphasis on Japan followed by only a day or two the terrifle licking the Japanese communists took at the polis his general election voting. Some observers in that part of the world believe, however, that this setback would serve only to integrify general communist activities regarding Japan.

Netther Stallin's book nor the Pelpingeneral, in themselves, gives us very much that is consistive on Russian plans, but taken together they indicate a pattern. It might be a pattern we should keep a sharp eye on.


