



NEW TUNE BY STRAUS

While in a sense, Pat Munroe, Times-News Washington correspondent, was right in re-porting that U. B. Commissioner of Recisma-tion Mike Straus had sprung a surprise by saying "there will-have-to-be-more local and state control of reclamation," the commis-sioner's change of tune is easy to understand.

There is no reason to believe that President-Elect Elechower will think any more of Straus as a result of the latter's recent pronuncement, and the commissioner's plans to resign with the change of administrations should not be hampered in any way.

No one in high government-circles demonstrates better than Straus himself the objectionable attitude that is characteristic of the vast-Wachington bureaucracy built up during 20 years of Democratic leadership.

It's putting it mildly to describe Straus as being "arrogant."

Even in his obvious attempt to change his Even in his obvious attempt to change his familiar tune in reclamation matters, Straus could not refrain from a sneering, belitting attitude toward the opinions of others. He is so accustomed to having his own way, largely as a result of executive action rather than congressional support, that anything he might offer now in the way of a compromise would only sound insincers.






