ATOM POWER EVER NEARER

AUM PUWER EVER NEARER While politicians have been spouting hot air all over the landscape, experts on atomic energy in recent weeks and months have been making a series of speeches with a real impact on the future of civilization, even though few people have been paying any attention to them.

tention to them. What has happened is that the age of atomic energy for the production of electric power has come a lot closer to dawning than most people have imagined.

The first atomic chain-reactor experiment took place Dec. 3, 1942—not quite 10 years ago. The first news about it was released after the fiftenshims bomb was exploded in

1945. When, shortly after that, the first appraisals were made on peacetime uses of atomic energy, it was figured that a generation or two might pass—25 to 50 years—before atomic energy might be harnessed for such peacetime, civilian uses as the production of elec-

ic power.
Today that estimate has been cut to 5 to

10 years.

Listen to Gordon Dean, chairman of the atomic energy commission, speaking before the American Bar association in San Fran-

the American Bar association in Ban Fran-cisco:

"This new expansion (of the atomic energy program) is designed to reach the minimum military stockpile (of atomic weapons) at least four and possibly five years earlier than would otherwise have been the case...?. The current atomic arms race cannot go on forever. Somewhere along the line there is a point... where we will have acquired all the weapons to destroy..., not only the in-dustrial ability of an aggressor to make war, but also his ferces in the field.

"When this point is reached and it is not in the unforsceable future... What do we do then?... The obvious answer is to make a de-termined sifort now to develop the peaceful uses of atomic energy.






