RIDDLE FOR CONGRESS

The development of atomic power by pri-vate enterprise for industrial and commercial use presents the new President and the new congress with a problem just as explosive as the A-bombs of H-bombs themselves.

the A-nombs of H-Dombs-themselves.

The reason is that the present atomic energy law makes a flat prohibition against private ownership of facilities for producing fissionable materials.

Itsolomble materials.
When this law, fathered by the late Sen.
Brien McMahon of Connecticut, was passed
in 1846, the big idea in congress was to give
the U. S. government a complete monopoly
on atomic energy. This is not apply to the
raw materials that were into manufacture
of manium and puttonium, the itsalomable
of materials themselves, the plants in which
they were processed or made into bombs and
all patients relating thereto.

aney were processed or made into borned and in patents relating thereto.

Now, six years later, the picture has changed. The U.S. monopoly is gone. Russha and Britain have bombs of their own. The prospects for international control of atomic energy production for peaceful uses have dimmed almost to the variabing point. Countries like Beigium and The Netherlands, with limited supplies of coal and no petroleum, are looking toward the use of atomic power as prime sources of energy. With control over the rich, uranium mines of the Congo, the Beigians are beginning to wonder why all their raw materials should go to the U.S. for processing.

why all their raw materials should go to the U.S. for processing. On top of this, engineering brains have caught up with scientific brains at a more rapid rate than was expected. The use of atomic energy for-the development of electric power is now conceded to be a lot closer than was thought possible five years ago. Private industry is clamoring to self in the atomic energy set, either as a short-ange or a long-range phosetion ray as a constance of the control of th

vernment's atomic energy commission ems to be switching its viewpoint some

seems to be switching its vise-point somewhat.

Maybe it limit a good idea for the government to have this atomic energy monopoly.

Maybe-the-great, competitive free enterprise system could find new ways to purify uran-ium-and-maks. it into plutonium. Maybe it could do this at less cost than the government lays out in its multi-billion-dollar blants.

that it would be a subsidy to the private power industry.

This would put that industry on the horns of the neatest dilemma ever devised. For years the private power industry has fought public power as unfair competition and a subsidy to the government's preferred customers. In the present atomic energy power contonics, the private power industry would itself have to be subsidized to make atomic power production a profitable business.

From all these factors it can be seen what a nice light the new congress has ahead of it, trying to resolve this atomic riddle.






