

They point out that the new GE lab—as one amail example of what is happening all over—was built on the assumption that during the next 10 years there will be twice as much electrical energy being used in the U.S. as there was during the whole past 65-year period since electric power first started to be usedain large quantities. And this assumption is based on the conviction that atomic electricity will be the most important part of the new aupply.

Many of the lab's projects are classified secret but the most significant piece of equipment so far developed there, which can be talked about, is a signatic switch called an interruptor. The AEC experts admit that it is an integral part of the whole harness system which will have to be put together eventually to control atomic energy as electrical power.

Its job is to stand-as sort-of automatic watchman between the generating facility or a sudden dangerous upawing of power in the plant.

It could turn off all of the power generated at Boulder dam, for instance, in a split second.

NATO WAITS FOR IKE

NATO WATIS FOR IKE

The members of the North Atlantic treaty organization have wisely decided to put their 1953 defense planning for Europe on a tentative basis until they can hear what General Elsenhower proposes for NATO.

The NATO council is set to meet Dec. 15 to set next year's military goals. But it now appears a second meeting, in March, will be held to modify or confirm these goals in the light of later American developments.

Except as a preliminary, the Dec. 15 date seems utterly impractical, anyway! Natro makes up its plans for the calendar year. But America, chief source of economic and military aid, votes this assistance by the fusual year—starting and ending in July.

Thus, in December, NATO can never know what amount of help to expect after July 1 of the following year. The participating countries can measure the first six months, of course, since money for such aid always is voted by congress in the previous spring. But that's not enough of a guide.
