

UNION SHOP FIGHT LOOMS

Early next spring the new administration is going to run headlong into its first rash of labor troubles.

iabor troubles.

Contract negotiations will begin for electrical, rubber, textile, meatpacking, shipbuilding, paper, utility and machinery workers, to amme a few. For several reasons the clash between labor and management in this bargaing is expected to be especially sharp. There's a good chance that one or more major strikes may result.

a good chance that one or more inayle saless, may result.

According to the strategists for both sides, they want to find out as soon as possible just how the new leaders in Washington are going to stand on labor generally. Will Ike be as pro-management as the new and fair deals Inave been por-labor? "Are labor's fears of retailstion groundless? Will Ike adopt a strictly middle-of-the road policy on labor?

Those are the questions both labor and management want answered, and the central issue in these exploratory fights is going to be union security, or more specifically the union atop. With the general business outlook steady for at least another year, wages are not expected to be a major issue.

Union security refers generally to such

pected to be a major issue. Union security refers generally to such things as the check-off of dues by the company and maintenance of membership. The union ahop is the most important aspect of union security and refers to forcing a worker to be a member of the union in order to hold his job. There are variations of this compulsion.

The current house investigation into campaign spending should prove one of the most useful inquiries in—many—years—The—1659 presidential contest showed emphatically how outdated are the present laws governing political expenditures.

Under existing statutes each national party committee is limited to a \$3,000,000 outlay per campaign. In practice, the major parties long ago found the way to get around this handican, Auxiliary citizens' groups, volunties recommittees, subdidiaries of established organisations like labor—unions, these and others. labor unions, the lect and disburse campaign funds of their

They, too, are naturally restricted by the \$3,000,000 ceiling for particular committees, but the sum of their operations can and usually does exceed measurably the total for the official party.

usually does exceed measurably the total for the official party organization. The legal limit, prescribed in-1939, has obviously been unrealistic for some years. The 1932 campaign reduced it to absurdity. Television, campaigning by plane, and a few other modern features, pitted on top of the standard expenses for radio, newspaper advertising and publicity, trait travel and more vertising and publicity trait travel and more caravans, have sent costs into outer space. A recent New York Times survey indicates that at least \$22,000,000 was spent by both parties this time, and possibly a great deal more.
