Thorny Slot Machine Puzzle Due for Legislative Hearing

BOISE, Jan. 2 (AP)—The slot machine puzzle that has troubled every legislative session since 1945—promises to crop up again in the 22nd legislative session, convening here Monday.

At least one senator-elect made repeal of the slot machine law part of his campaign platform. Edna A. Solon, lawyer Harry Keeler, representing the Allied Civic Forces of Idaho, has promised that after January 13, when the legislature convenes, legislation will be introduced for the third time since 1945.

U. S. Airlines Chalk Record In Past Year

WASHINGTON, Jan. 2 (AP)—The nation's airlines set a new safety record in 1952 while handling more traffic than ever before, the Air Transportation Association says.

The association's director of research, Dr. Lewis O. Sorensen, gave these figures Wednesday in a year-end summary.

"The airline industry carried more than 27 million passengers, 47 per cent more than in 1951. The passenger safety record for domestic operations went down from 1.3 to 0.36 passengers per 100 million passenger miles.

The volume of revenue traffic was 16.6 billion passenger miles, up 17.3 per cent. Cargo volume went above 600 million tons, up 21 per cent. Mail ton miles topped 97 million, up seven per cent.

Operating expenses grew up 13.8 per cent to a total exceeding 1 billion dollars.

The air-transportation board said the previous safety record for U. S. scheduled domestic carriers was 1.1 deaths per 100 million passenger miles.

There were no available estimates of military air accident deaths.

Return to Self-Financing Crop Aid Plans Eyed for Ike's Term

WASHINGTON, Jan. 2 (AP)—The incoming Eisenhower administration probably will seek ways of returning to the "self-financing" features of early new deal farm programs.

The Republicans are committed to broad price support programs which over the last 18 years have cost taxpayers slightly more than a billion dollars.

But President-Elect Eisenhower as well as Ezra Taft Benson, his choice to be secretary of agriculture, have made known a desire to reduce the cost of price support programs.

Early new deal programs were financed in part by what were called processing taxes. But the tax levied on the first processing operation of a farm product, such as the milling of wheat into flour, slaughter of hogs for pork, and so on. This tax was knocked out by a 1938 Supreme Court decision which declared the existing agricultural adjustment to be unconstitutional.

Since that time, costs of supporting farm prices have fallen on the treasury.

Methods of self-financing price guarantee programs discussed by farm leaders in recent years include two-price systems, processing taxes and crop insurance.

Under the two-price system, farmers would contribute to a fund to finance export of surplus at a rate price. They would get the benefit of a high-level supported price on products consumed domestically minus a deduction for the export fee.

Under the processing tax plan, the government would collect fees from processing of farm products. The money obtained would be used to pay costs of supporting prices of affected farm commodities. Such a tax now pays the cost of supporting grower prices of sugar cane and sugar beets.

Under the price insurance plan, growers would take out government insurance policies to protect their crops against price declines below designated levels.

The price insurance and the self-financing type of two-price plan differ from the processing tax in one major feature. The cost of the former would be borne by farmers while the processing tax would be borne, in the final analysis, by consumers of the farm products involved.

DURKIN OPPOSES STRIKES

Martin Patrick Durkin, the 38-year-old general president of the plumbers' union who has been secretary of labor on Jan. 20, can be put down as a craft union leader of the old school.

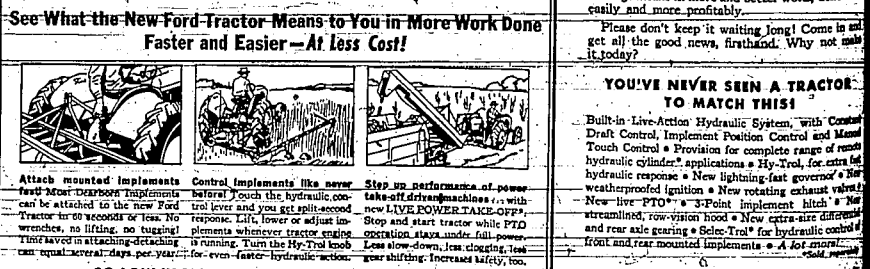
