



PATRONAGE SEEKERS

From Washington come continuing reports the Requisions in consersus are somewhat disgrantied over the way their new President; Ceneral Essenhower, Tas been handling patronage and other affairs.

Senator-Tatt's line-up over the appointment of Martin Durkin to be secretary of labor was only the most celebrated incident. There have been many other cases where senators have lasared in the newspapers about appointments affecting their states. But right here a distinction ought to be made between different kinds of patronage. Some of the forumblers seem to be saying they ought to have virtually a "final-say" on appointments of home-state citizens clear up to cabinet level. Actually, they cannot man that, A President's cabinet choices shouldnot be subject to individual senatorial velo, except in the most extreme circumstances. Slimply as a matter of courtesy, such choices ought to be discussed with the affected senators, but normally their influence should be only advisory.






