

A lot of people are saying these days that this conflict is not inevitable, that congress and the White House can get along fine it seek will just stick to it sankting and if there is constant consultation between the two. Itsenhower, a man of tremendous islent for bringing people together, is pictured as just the fullow to introduce sweetness and light into this age-old relationship. Without be blittling for an instant the general's capacity for compromise, one may still suggest that conflict will not be worlded indefinitely.

The—underlying—reason is that no chief executive in this or any other day can stop being a mere administrator, leaving to congress the making of all law, and hence policy. In the first place, let to its own evices, congress does not produce a comprehensive, well-harmonized program of action, it tands to fall apart into factions, each pressing its own aims. Whate emerges is otten lost in controlicions.

own aims. What emerges is often lost in con-tradictions. tradictions.

This happens to a congress without White-Rouse-leadership because lawmakers are not elected by the whole people but by the citates are of a district or state. If they are high-minded men they will think often of the autional interest, but they impore their state and faithful congress at the risk of their confidences.

The Fresident, on the other hand, is elected by the entire citisenry, and he is chosen as more than a referee among competing factions. He is truly the nation's leader, and it is so empowered by the constitution, even though that document-puts, checks on him. The founding fathers gave him authority to make treaties, to advise congress on policy, and to veto legislation. Almost from the first, American Freeldents have used that power pocitively and aggressively to promote programs of broad national interest—authory say it. Endlessly, they have fought congress.

Today, with the separate segments of american society more vocal and more powerful seconomically, and politically than erretefore, the demand for railing White House guidance is the greatest printery. Only the President can thread a fairly consistent course, through the bewilderments of foreign affairs.

The President who uses his power to the hilt is apparently here to stay. And so are the conflicts with congress which logically follow.
