WASHINGTON—Sen. Homer Ferguson, Michigan, still wants a comprehensive congressional investigation into the "day of infamy" he does not believe the truth has been told to the American people.

HOW THINGS APPEAR FROM PEGLER'S ANGLE

WASHINGTON—During my interview with Carmel Offie, a past member of the weird system of secret billing and controlling operated by our government in cahoots with the AFL, another man sat by.

The subject of Westbrook Pegler's my mission was in 1943 on a charge of a homosexual offense but the state department's cynical resort to the American Federation of Labor as an "instrument" of intrigue and cold warfare in Panama, Latin Greece and other "friendly" nations.

I must interrupt myself to say that Offie said he was framed, being slugged by four or five men and thrown into a cell, when he went to a corner of La Fayette park across from the White House, to keep a rendezvous in compliance with an official order of the state department.

He abandoned his \$25 bond without defending himself. He said neither he nor his lawyer saw the police charge at the time although his lawyer did read it later.

The friend at Offie's side has held the rank of minister and seemed thorough in the system of intrigue, our state department and, latterly, the central intelligence agency have borrowed from the old world.

He said that, of course, it was very immoral of us to violate the sovereignty of friendly nations in order to wage our politico-military and economic cold war against Soviet Russia.

But it was necessary nevertheless. He said Soviet propaganda was making use of my disclosures to discredit the United States.

So when the CIA wanted to plant an "ambassador" in the AFL, Offie was selected and the AFL put him on its payroll in May 1950.

DEMOCRATIC MARVEL

Millions of American citizens had cause to be grateful for the electronic miracles that allowed them a seat at the side of history in the first coast-to-coast telecast of a presidential inauguration.

But the real marvel of that day was not a scientific but a distinctly human triumph. It was the simple inaugural ceremony caught in the lens of the television camera.

This marvel began to unfold when the then still President-elect, Mr. Eisenhower, drove up to the White House steps in a black open car just half an hour before the hour of inauguration. He had come to pick up President Truman.

At the steps, Mr. Eisenhower and his wife, Mamie, climbed out of the car. Mr. Truman and his wife and daughter came briskly out from the White House. Warm, smiling greetings were exchanged. Then Mr. Eisenhower asked: "Shouldn't we be going?"

The workfolk drifted off to another car, conversely smiling and waving, and started the ride down Pennsylvania Avenue to the capitol. As they rode, there was little talking. But both looked cheerful and relaxed.

Up on capitol hill, the two men disappeared inside the capitol to wait while lesser dignitaries arrived. Then the wondrous moment was at hand, the magic seconds that held all the mystery and majesty and simplicity of the democratic process.

Down the steps to the platform came Mr. Truman, as a band played "Hail to the Chief" in his honor for the last time. Quietly he stepped aside to take a seat to the right of the speaker's lectern. In that unobtrusive act was the whole essence of the laying down of power in America.

The hands of the clock inched forward. Mr. Eisenhower stepped into view with his escort, with a band playing "Stars and Stripes Forever." He took a seat to the left. It seemed but an instant until the preliminaries were over and he was on his feet, taking the oath of office from Chief Justice Vinson.

Thirty-six words, uttered in a firm voice edged with emotion, and he had picked up the reins of power. He had picked up Mr. Truman as about a year before.

Now he was holding the prayer he had written for this occasion, and then the new President plunged into his brief address. As he spoke, the old President sat thoughtfully in his chair, here and there applauding, always respectfully attentive.

Then Mr. Eisenhower turned, acknowledged congratulations from those on the platform, and walked back up the steps he had come down. As he did, the band struck up once more, playing "Hail to the Chief" for him for the first time.

Mr. Truman, knowing well his time on the stage had passed, quietly stepped off the platform, almost unnoticed. Down wooden stairs he went to the street, to a waiting closed car and thence out of the turbulent current of American government.

What a pity it is that the whole world could not have watched the Americans did. For this great and unscripted, peaceful transfer of power speaks perfectly the real meaning of democracy—the right of free men to choose and to change, their leaders by non-violent processes whose ultimate verdict is accepted by all with good will.

IRONY IN COLD RUSSIA

There is tremendous irony in the whole Russian communist effort to present its case to the world.

From the start red leaders have understood the apparatus both to the power and to the downtrodden millions, of its program of sweeping collective action engineered in the people's name.

The magnets have been the ideal of co-operation to achieve the good of all, the tangible nature of the cause, the apparent system of order in a world of shattering chaos.

That the ideal and the cause have been basically fraudulent seem not to have hurt them materially in some places. The communist idea still exerts tremendous pull.

But what has hurt is the reds' repeated need to yield to the ruthless demands of the game of power politics their leaders are playing. And so, again and again, they have been compelled to expose their raw brutality, to maintain their crude cult of power intact.

In the 1920's there were killings and exiles. From 1934 to 1938, the bloodiest purges in Soviet history. The internal power of the communist dream. Now, once more, the heads are rolling, with the heavy weight falling upon the Jews of Russia and the satellites.

These things cannot be kept secret, and they cannot be avoided in a regime that really is nothing but a self-perpetuating power group. It is the only way.

The internal power of the communist dream and devours every vestige of the dream that was fashioned as this shining lure to attract the world to its false banners.
