Former President Truman apparently was going almost entirely on his personal hunch when he recently-voiced-doubt that Russia, has an atomic bomb. For while he was in the

In his recent statement Mr. Truman appeared to be suggesting that the Russians had from time to time unleashed some sort of experimental "nuclear explosion" which was short of a real atomic bomb.

That's not what his technical advisers told him at the time he made the initial annuncement of Soviet atomic developments. They said, in unmistakable language, that 19 the Russians had not exploded an atomic bomb, then they could not imagine what it

They were saying, in other words, that after exhaustive analysis of all the scientific eridence available to them, they had con-cluded that the facts fit no other sensible

cluded that the facts fit no other sensible pattern.

What kind of evidence did they rely upon? For one thing seismographic checks like those which measure earthquake shocks anywhere on the globe. For another, amazingly accurate samplings of the upper atmosphere which can disclose the presence of radioactive substances and other products of atomic fission. Those materials often travel around the earth in the upper air several times. Senator Fisickenicoper of Jowa, former Republican chairman of the senate-house atomic energy committee, says if the Russians can release any atomic explosion when they want to, then they can make bombs, because there is little difference in the technical skill required for the two processes.


