

PROPOSED TRAFFIC CODE

A uniform-highway code, covering nearly every phase of traffic regulation, has been introduced in the Idaho house of representatives, and it now remains to be seen whether the legislature will adopt it.

As everyone familiar with Idaho's traffic laws knows, there are many loopholes in these statutes and some are entirely inadequate to cope with all the slaughter and destruction on our highways.

The uniform code, submitted for the state legislature's consideration, is patterned atterner recommendations of the national conference and street and highway safety. According to its sponsors, the proposed code has the endorsement of the President's highway safety conferences and 38 state highway safety conference and 38 state highway safety conferences.

It covers the field of uniform traffic laws, standards of road design and use, traffic signs and signals, regulations for pedestrians, penalities for violations, speed limits and all the other factors bearing on highway safety.

As it now stands, Idaho down't even have

As it now stands, Idaho ddesn't own have a speed limit. It a driver can prove he's operating his car "seatonably" and "prudently", he can barrel it down the road at 125 miles an hour, without fear of any serious consequences in court.

There have been as warm to the control of the

There have been so many interpretations of our ineffective traffic laws, that the average driver can all but get by with murder, so long as he is not caught in the actual process of killing someone. And even in such extreme instances, some drivers responsible for traffic deaths have had clear salling through our courts, only to continue as potential killers on our highway.

The proposed code establishes a speed limit and serious penaltiels for such offenses as reckless driving, negligent homicide and funken driving. Upon conviction, for instance, a driver responsible for negligent homicide, would be subject to a prison sentence of one year, a fine of \$1,000, or both, and his driver's license could be revoked permanently.

On first offense, an individual found guity of reckless driving could be sentenced to a minimum of five days in jall and a maximum fine of \$300. Upon second conviction, he would fee liable for a maximum fail sentence of six months and revocation of his

license for one year.

There will be a lot of opposition to a 60-mile-per-hour speed limit and various other provisions in the proposed highway code, and it will remain for the legislature to decide whether it's more concerned about such opposition, or has a higher regard for the mounting toll of human lives being lost on our highways—a record that's most disgraceful.

The legislative committee of the Magic Valley Safety conference has gone over the proposed code in detail, and, with recom-mendations for minor changes to make it even more effective, has endorsed the meas-ure whole-heartedly.

Let's hope at long last, the state legislature faces this issue squarely and chacts the legis-lation that's needed to cope with a problem endangering all of our lives.

Nevertheless, the Yugoslavs, for all their communist government, are seen as a powerful ally. The Weat wheely extends aid to Tito, and there have been informal strategy talks looking toward a linking of effort in event of a Russian attack.

The plan for a definite pact incorporating Yugoslavia, Greece and Turkey is perhaps the strongest move that can be made formsly to the Tito into the NATO system. This regional arrangement, would presumably have all the binding force of any military alliance, yet it would get around the embarrassing business of asking Tito to join the full family.
