

In non-communist circles there is no ten-dency anywhere to dispute the guilt of the convicted atomic spies, Julius and Anna Ro-senberg, who now are under sentence of

death.

The only point at issue during the long period of appeals and requests for elementy was whether a sentence of death was too severe. No person have ever before been executed in peacetime for espionage in the United States.

Those who said it should not happen this time cited the precedent, pointed out that the Rosenbergs' wartime spying was done when Russia was our ally, and declared their execution would make them marryrs whom the Reds could exploit.

the Reds could exploit.

People arguing the other way said the Rosenbergs tried to spy after the war when Russia no longer was an any, and would do so today if they could. (Only a few days before sentencing, they reaffirmed their innocence to their two children). They have flatly declined to help this country find other spies.

Moreover, their explorage involved weapons capable of colosal destruction. As President Eisenhower expressed it in refusing clemency, their crime could "very well result in the death of many, many thousands of innocent clittens."

It was the magnitude of their offense.

It was the magnitude of their offense—
measured thus—plus the Rosenbergs' stubborn refusal to acknowledge either to themselves or anyone else what they had done,
which probably accounted for the imposition
of the death penalty.

In the minds of those who inflicted this
penalty was undoubtedly the question: How
can we discusde others from taking the Rosenbergs' course? How can we thereby assure
our country greater protection from spic
spawned within America?

They decided death would be the best les-jon to others. They evidently felt, too, that death was the only punishment that fit the Rosenbergs' crime.

Opponents of capital punishment naturally disagree with this answer. This is no place to explore all phases of that problem. It is enough to note that capital punishment is provided for some federal offenses, and in many states for such crimes as murder and kidnaping.

In the Rosenberga' case, a penalty we large-by accept for many severe crimes was applied in a wholly new field, for the evident reason that special factors made their offense ex-tremely reprehensible to the American peo-

Pas. for martyring these two and giving the Russians propaganda material, this can only be a secondary concern to us. Our task is to mete out full justice to all. If we do that unfailingly, we cannot worry too much how our processes of justice, are misrepresented by men who believe in no justice whatsoever. Our judicial system is designed to protect both the nation and the individual. It will not serve these twin goals long if its operations are tempered especially to avoid giving advantage to enemy propaganda. The aims of American justice, well pursued, stand on their own. They are not relative to anything Moscow thinks or does.

CONANTS NEW DUTIES

James Bryant Conants arrival in Bonn to assume his duties as U. S. high commissioner to Germany signals at once the start of an ardious task for him and the end of a rather sad chapter in the lite of the new congress.

Certainly Conant, for all his remarkable achievements as a chemist, an educator and a statesmanilise citizen, should not have expected or have enjoyed any special immunity from congressional scrutiny. The post he undertakes is a crucial one, and the law-makers, as the people's representatives, have a right to measure his qualifications carefully.
