

WHO'S CRYING THE LOUDEST?.

The hottest issue confronting the Elsenhower administration since it took over is the gradual decline in farm prices. By their detay clamor in congress, both Republicans and Democrats have shown they appreciate the Louitted potency for 1954 and 1956.

What the American people must decled for themselves, lowever, is whether, most of this, clamor originates with the farmers (heimselves, or is being trumped up by opportunist politicians who are always eager to make capital of any issue that will serve their selfish motives.

i There is good reason to believe that the politicians are more steamed up about farm prices than are those about whom they appear so concerned. The farmers and cattlemen have indicated they are more inclined to wait and see what will-develop, instead of condemining the Eisenhower administration so early in iddge western farmer expressed it:

The farmers haven't risen up with pitch-corks in hand as some would lead you to believe.

The farmers haven't risen up with pitchjove."

Naturally the farmers are uneasy over the
jopp in prices. But no runaway alarms are
ringing through the midrest to match some
of the political futor kicked up in Washington. In fact there has been considerable talk
that the price decline was inevitable and
that government price props aren't the whole
answer to farm security.

Even the nation's tattlemen, in spite of the
beating they, have been taking, insist that
the Eisenhower administration is on the
right track. So the fact that Senator Kerr,
Democrat from Oklahoma, is crying his eyes
out over the cattlemen's pilght doesn't take
on so much meaning after all.

For the record it ought to be made clear

On the other hand, the farmer's protection about not be of such character as to encourage him to produce unwanted surpluses (by the lure of high support prices). A support law that operates thus will at once price the farmer out of the market and leave him producing ultimately for the government alone.

In this connection, the meaning of protection ought to he made clearer. There is no automatic virtue, for the farmer in a high price. The aim of the government is to assure him his fair share of the national price, and in the forest of the farmer, you would gather that the goal is to puah farm prices to record heights and then guarantee that they will never get any lower there where the these that they will never get any lower where the seventee is difficult to see.
