

STEVENSON'S "CARELESSNESS".

Adial Stevenson's first major speech since his defeat for the presidency was admirable in its generalities of fair-minded opposition and its tone of good-humored sportsmanship. But when it descended to particulars of criticism against the new administration, it often showed a giaring lack of facts.

Stevenson's celebrated sense of humor obviously was not a casualty of the election. He made his little jokes and turned many a happy phrase.

nappy phrase.

In more sober vein, he pledged constructive opposition to President Eisenhower and the Republican Sard congress, and said the government would have Democratic support so long as it worked in the public and the national interest.

tional interest.

He declared, more sensibly than many of his eager followers, that 25 days is too short a span in which to judge a new President. He proposed to blet time and allow the Elsenhower administration full chance to develop

Despite these fine resolves, however, Stevenson could not resist commenting upon some events since Jan 20, especially in the foreign field. And here he strayed sady from

foreign field. And here he strayed sadly from the facts.

Secretary of State Dulles' recent blunt warnings to western Europe on the issue of European unity seemed to Stevenson a sign we have turned to bullying our allies and ignoring their legitimate doubte and fears.

Stevenson apparently felt Dulles' conduct in Europe resembled the 'bull, in the china shop,' and he implied a contrast to Democratic handling of these matters, the seemed to suggest further that much American opinion runs contrary to the Dulles approach. But the fact is that the overwhelming majority of Americans support this new tack, including many Democrats in congress, and many of Stevenson's friends in the state department.

Stevenson also erred in assuming that other administration moves in the foreign field add up to an ineptity conceived plan for psychological warfare against the communists.
