

### ALLIES WILD ALARMS

Henry Cabot Lodge, America's ambassador to the United Nations, has canvasced the rotter of U. N. countries who are helping in the allied right in Korea, and has found them singularly unenthusiastic about any new war moves.

As an immediate practical matter, this is not a great-cause for worry, since the United States itself is planning no shattering new offensives. But as an indication of attitude, Lodge's survey results are disheartening.

Britain, France and India (not a combatant

Britain, France and India (not a combatant but a strong influence on Korean issues) have brought themselves to a state of mind where they see any action whatsoever is fraught with unimaginable perils. The capture of more than one of two communist dugues a week is seen as leading to "enlargement of the war."

This mood is all too reminiscent of the
1930's, when a spirit of, "peace at any price"
produced a war that nearly ground free men's

One is reminded of the "Bore war" phase of World war II, when France, with a 6-million-man army, "helped" embattled, Foland by "exerting pressure" on nast Germany's western proders. This valiant effort compelled nair soldiers to yank down clothes-lines they had strung in front of outpost foriffications, but accomplished little size.

The fact that we do not now contemplates one kind of big push is secondary. What is important is the failure of these other nations to propose any variety of constructive suggestion, for the presention or conclusion of the Korean war. (We are leaving out truce efforts on the ground that the reds have shown they have no sincere intentions toward peace at this time.)

We have a right to expect from our felium combatant—and from Indis—more than fresuded alarms every time we hint that a stalematic war limit's good state of affairs and that something ought to be done to get the free world out of it.

At the present time, the United States stempting to frame a policy that calls for the gradual withdrawal of ground forces of, the U. N. from Koreal and of France from Indo-China, Since this program is the very opposite of policies which would "enlarge the war." It should appeal mightily to France and Riviatin.

It calls for the active buildup or South Korean armies in Korea and Vietnamese armies in Indo-China. That means more training and more equipment and together they spell more money.

The U. S. inevitably will have to bear a large share of that burden, but it is wholly fair to exact from our allies a heavier financial contribution than they have thus far been making either in Europe or the far each. This seems not too much to ask of nations whose idea of protecting themselves against a menacing foe is to counsel timidity and flar no big muscles until the enemy is almost at the gates.
