BUTTER OVER PRODUCTION

Secretary of Agriculture Benson has made his first critical moye. It was not a decision for government retrenchment in farm price supports, as might have been expected from some of Benson's public statements. It was, rather, for their continuance in the vital dairy field.

The law gives Benson the option to set dairy price supports for the year starting April 1 at a level from 75 to 90 per cent of parity. Parity is a price level calculated to assure the farmer his fair share of the national trend three. tional income.

For the current year supports on dairy products had been fixed at 90 per cent. Benon announced he will continue them at the

same level.

But, though this decision is of course pleasing to the farmers immediately concerned and may help to arrest a long decline in general farm prices, it also poses other problems acutely.






