



OUR MIXED EMOTIONS

In summarising the grist of last week's news, one cannot help but feel a sense of real apprehension over developments abroad, par-ticularly those two incidents in which Soviet jets shot down an American and a British

jets shot down an American and a British plane.

Up and down the streets of Twin Falls and every-other-community in the United States there was the feeling that our estrangement with Russia is becoming very tense, indeed.

Are the Russians bating us? Are they employing these tactics to create an apparent emergency to unite their own ranks at home? Or are they actually flexing their muscles preparatory to an outright approach to war? These are questions we have been asking ourselves, fearful of the possibility that the fuse already has been ignited on a great world wide powder keg.

The startling news that our own forces have been worfully short of ammunition in Korea only added to our apprehension.

Even in these troubled times, of course, the

Even in these troubled times, of course, the news is not all had, and millions of Americans are thanking their lucky stars this countrinally brought about a change in national administration, take as it was in coming. The ammunition shortage in Korea, the 3700,000 "pium" which was handed out to riving officials of the Truman administration for "unused leave time," and various other evidences of inefficiency and various other evidences of inefficiency and abused patronage privileges were added reminders that this country's national affairs had degenerated to a precarious level under the previous administration.

to a processor.

Now, it was reassuring at least to know that we have a national administration which is facing all our country's problems

which is facing all our country's problems realistically.

Instead of talking in platitudes and throwing money to the four winds, as did the previous administration when the threat of another world war kiredy was staring us in the face, the Esenhower forces are losing no time in trying to correct this country's recent mistakes. Not all the actions now being taken would pass the test of political expediency. But in the main they would appear to be in the country's good.

But in the main they would appear to be in the country's good.

At least the American people now have the feeling there is to be no more compromise with the Russian menace, no more appeara-ment to our disadvantage—something of which they could not be sure before Presi-dent Eisenhower took office and started cleaning house.

dent Eisenhower took office and started cleaning house. Whatever results from the death of Stalin, from Soviet jets shooting down allied planes, and from other over tacts which only point to another war, perhaps sooner than we realize, it will be comforting to know that the government of this country is now in capable hands.

Even the trumped up opposition for opposi-tion's sake, directed at President Essenhower and members of his cabinet, Secretary of Ag-riculture Benson particularly, was turning out to be a fixeroo. Anyone could see that most of such opposition was 100 per cent po-litical

most of such opposition was 100 per cent political. In spite of all the dire warnings, the new
government under President Eisenhower continued to abolish price ceilings on consumer
goods, until a very few remained. And the
crises which the former bureaucrats predicted failed to materialize.

That, too, was a good sign, because it gave
American people renewed assurance that its,
still possible for them to stand on their own
feet like free men and women, instead of
being wet-nursed by a solicitous government,
eager to make them nothing more than responsite puppets dangling on federal strings.

In a good many respects, the menacing

In a good many respects, the menacing cloud of war which seemed to be gathering along the horizon abroad, was more than offset by the rebirth of Americanism right here at home. Many Americanism long have wondered whether the subversive influences at work within our borders were not actually more dangerous to our country than the Russians themselves. It's far easier to flight a foe you can see and recognize than to overthrow those shister influences that work under cover, to some of the highest places in the very government they seek to destroy.

It was good to know therefore that the round-up within our country was well under way, before the conspirators could command enough power to hand us over to the enemy without a struggle.

On the home front, we carried on very nuch as usual, in spite of our concern over evelopments abroad and our interest in hints being done-to-put-this-country-back.
