

One thing that has impressed them meat
is the relation of foreign policy to what goes
on in this country. When Secretary of Defense Chaire E. Wilson goes to Secretary of
Tressury George M. Rumphrey and says that
the armed services will have to have so
many billions of dollars, that fact determines a
lot of things.

It determines what the tax rate of the
United States will box it determines how much
of America's supply of raw material will be
chewed up in manufacture of arms. And it
determines how many men will work in the
factories of Pittsburgh, Cleveland or Detroit
—and what it is they will be making for
a considerable period of time.

From the point of view of the business
executive in government, the United States
now faces two main problems.

In front of them, the people of the civilized
western world have the threat of enemies
with knives at their throats. Something must
be done to ward off this attack.

This means spending more than the western
countries can afford for national defense. It
this money is spent, and, by higher texation
and borrowing, the economy of the non-cofamunit world is ruined, affairs may be no
better off than they would be if the men with
the knives were allowed to attack.

So a decision has to be made on

defense in the last two years fairly well.

But if this defense betwer has to be maintained for 10 years are not only when the main

The inflation that invariably accompanies
a period of rearmanent and war is sized up
as an extremely cangerous thing. It begins

The best thing to do—that is, the most popular—is not necessarily the wisest thing to do for the long haul. For the future course of government operations it raises the possibility that all-out social security programs and 100 per cent government parity payments for farmers—while nice and no doubt desirable—may have to be postponed. There are no firm decisions on these matters or any of the other 64-billion-dollars worth of questions that still face the Eisenhower administration. 




