But if a dozen of the most important tax law revisions could be made next year, that would be considered a start in the right direction.

One other factor bearing on this situation is President Risenhower's proposal for a commission to study the relationship between federal and state governments. Elimination of duplicate taxtion is one of the primary goals of this project.

But this field raises some little-understood problems. One proposal is to get the federal government out of the grant-in-add program to the states for highway construction. This would be done by killing all federal taxes on gasoline and leaving that field or jaxation to the states.

New York, with a large number of automobiles and big gas alsa, would gain by this change. But states like Nevada would tose.

Similarly, it has been proposed that the states abandon income taxes, leaving this field exclusively to the federal government. Here New York would lose heavily. To states which the not levy an income tax it would make no difference.

The proposal to leave all sales and excise taxes to the states in exchange for abandoning their income taxes presents other complicatio
