





"Great has no hefer."

The expression means that a despot's power cannot result be transferred to a successor. The man who comes, after must earn the power in his own right.

This is as the of Russia after Hallings-tis of any transp in history. Georgi Malenkov has officially donned the late dictator's mantic. But that does not automatically clothe him with the same authority.

The very magnitude of Stallin's power, enhanced by the myth of his unaurpassed greatness and perfection, meant that none of the competitors for his place could have anything like his stature so long as he lived. Stalin was mester of the Communist party, the Soviet government, the secret police and the red army.

Mainton, his designated successor, is presumed master only of the party and government machinery. This is no minor advantage, but it is not what Stalin had, Malenkov rules by agreement of Moletox, Berta (secret police) and Bulganin (army), all of whom were only uightly below their new leader in preferment when Stalin died.

Very possibly this agreement was arrived at in advance, to give outward appearance both to the Russians and the world of a smooth, orderly transition. But as we have seen, the appearance is deceptive.

Malenkov will not be Stalin until he has made Berta, Moletov and Bulganin his absolutely faithful servants. To achieve that he will have to crust them as individual power factors, or they will have to yield their ambitions.

For years the new Bovist boss has spent is time executing or transmitting Stalin's ecisions. He is not today a prime decision-maker.

What can Malenkov do to create a legend for himsel? Obviously, at the minimum he must hold what Stalin acquired. If China or any of the satellites should weaken the ties of the Soviet empire, Malenkov will be marked

But his som words auggest his ambition is greater than merely to preserve Stallin's gains. In 1846 he said: "Greatly mistaken are those who think that one can live on the merits of the past. . Wise history shelves such people in the artives."

If Majenkor cannot press his rivals into genuine subservience, if he cannot construct a new myth around himself, then his present hold on the Soviet leadership will slip, and the reins of real power will pass to a stronger competitor.
