### WEST BERLIN NEEDS HELP

Mayor Frast Reuter of West Berlin, now this country seeking help on the problem East German refuges, stands in element contrast to his communist counterriers in the city's Red sector. arts in th

Though he is in many ways the most defiant of Berliners—and Berliners have made a specialty of detying the reds despite the nearness of danger—Reuter atrides about the streets without bodyguards.

But, across the tonal border, Moscow's puppet Germans, supposedly safe among fellow reds, don't stick their noises outside unless a couple of well-muscled chaperones are close behind. Rumor has it that the communits bodyguards are more nearly traveling jailers—insurance that the puppets don't skip to West Germany. Whatever attitude one more nearly traveling remains and their responsibility for World war II, it is imposible not to admire the courage that Berliners, at less, have shown living in the very shadow of a threat as great or greater than Hiller's nasism.

Berlin is the most exposed outpot in all

Berlin is the most exposed outpost in all the west, standing encircled by red, hordes. Any display of real weakness there and the hanners probably would have been hauled down long ago.

But the city is more than a stout western rampart. It is also the locale of the one great hole in the iron curtain. Only in Berlin can weatern journalists see for themselves how the communists operate (reporters in Moscow get more Kremlin-guided tours.) Only from Berlin's Eastern tone can retugees escape in any volume, for the reds have not yet figured how to stop the flow.

As everybody knows, that flow now has reached record proportions. It puts almost intolerable burdens on the seconomy of West Germany, which can find neither work nor the means for adequate relief of these un-






