Because the stability and growth of Idaho is being endangered by requests for way higher than our present economy justifies, we wish to present the following facts:-

- (A)-Our present contract-provides a basic carpenter rate of \$2.35 per hour or \$94.00-for-a-40-hour-week.
- (B) On February 28th, 1953 the Unions made the following request of this Associa-
 - Wages to become effective the first payroll period after April 1, 1953—Carpenters \$2.55 per hour or \$102.00 per 40-hour week.
 - 2. Holidays-Armistice Day shall be included as a holiday.
- 3. Travel time and subsistence—When the job is outside the city limits the employer shall pay for travel time one way at the regular rate, and when the job is over twenty-five (25) miles from the city limits the workmen shall be paid Four Dollars (\$4.00) per day, additional living expense.
- On-Congressional election-days employees will be allowed time
 off to vote, not to exceed two (2) hours, and without loss of
 pay, but in no case will the employee be paid if he does not vote.
- Carpenters shall have ample time in which to pick up their tools before quitting time.
- 6: The employers and unions agree to jointly share the expense of printing this agreement and working rules for the informa-tion of members of both groups.
- (C) Numerous meetings were held and attempts were made to arrive at just working conditions and fair wages, dictated by present economic condi-

tions. In order to create harmony to save the public from the devant ing-effect of a strike, the Contracto made the following proposal on Man 11, 1953:

- To increase wages to \$2.41 per hour for the basic carpeters effective as of April 1st, 1958, for those amplayer cursu on the payroll as of the date of acceptance.
- 2. The current agreement to be extended to April 1st, 1985.

- 3. That .08c an hour increase for the Nampa jurisdiction be pictured in effect as indicated under Item No. 1 above An addition. .05c per hour increase in this area on June 1st, 1983, a furniaddition .05c per hour increase. - 5. This offer is made with the understanding that it will be mitted to the membership of those unions represented by Rocky Mountain District Council of Carpenters for scope by vota.
- (D) In answer to our proposal, the unb rejected our offer and called a strik before any further negotiation med ings could be arranged.




