

Since ROK armies hold two thirds of the present line and their removal would leave their own country exposed to new communist invasion on a wide front, it is hard to see the sones of this threat. In truth, South Korean thinking on this whole problem is more colored by emotion than strengthened by good sense.

For some reason, President Eisenhower seems to have a fondness for Administrator Stassen, although there is no political basis for their friendship, Stassen opposed Ike in the Minnesota primary, barely edging out Ike's write-in-vote-And Eisenhower would have been nominated at Chicago, with or without Minnesota's delegates. So, even if the mutual security administration is abolished or reduced to only a shell, Stassen will probably got another assignment. Meanwhile he refuses to get rid of personnel, despite charges that it is one of the government's most overstuffed organizations. He has let out less than 100 employes, more than half of whom were foreigners serving overseas—clerks. messangers, interpretars, etc. He promises to fire about 1,000 in July, which will be a mere routine and necessary proceeding, in view of expected cuts in MSA appropriations.






