The Westinghouse executive told the employes that the East Pittsburgh plant alone recently had lost more than \$7,000,000 warnent of business and about a million man-nours of work by factory employes on government contracts given to foreign companies. On this business, he added, the U. S. government also had lost more than \$1,800,000 in taxes.

Since Jan. 1, 1952, he explained, the U. S. government has let 24 contracts for electrical equipment to foreign countries—contracts worth more than \$13,500,000, representing 1,700,000 hours of factory work lost to U. S. labor.


