

How can people judge the quality of their leaders when they must listen to accounts manufactured to sait the conveniences and projudices of men grinding their special axes?

Ferhaps the worst thing is that the authors sind advocates of rewritten history make of their product a doctrine and a faith. They are generally quite intolerant of those who do not accept every item of belief without change. "With us or against us," is the way it goes.

One may be forgiven for wishing we could all get back to the point where facts are viewed as worthy objectives, and not as irritating encumbrances marring the smooth surfaces of comfortably distorted history.
