

REDS' NEWEST FLIP-FLOP

While American public interest has been focused on Korean truce possibilities, recent developments in the Soviet zone of East Germany have been no less significant. They are highlighted by the latest case in which East German authorities relaxed a production speedup after 20,000 building trades workers had protested in East Berlin. The mere fact that anybody under a communist government control can protest against any decree is surprising enough in itself. But the fact that the workmen had their demands met is positively sensational. It is possible that the long-repressed workers, were inspired to the widespread richt that brought out Russian tanks and machine gluss and resulted in martial law beng declared.

When the U. S. high commissioner to Germany, former Harvard Fresident James B. Conant, returned to Washington early in June to tastify before congressional committees, he made one radio appearance in which he laid great atrees on the completeness of the separation between East and West Germany. He emphasised that this sovietization of Rest Germany had been intendified over the past year. From the very day on which the new "contractual agreement" peace treaty had been aligned last May between West Germany and the wastern allied powers, the Cast Germany and the surface had been closed at all points except the autobahn and the railroad into Event the Event the
