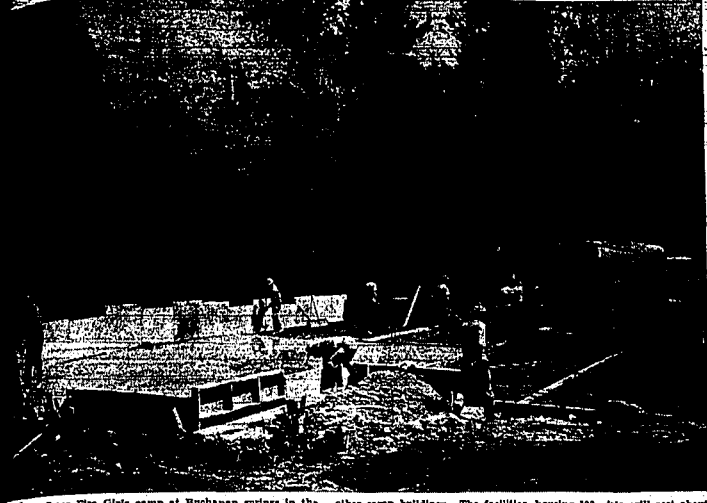

Big Dipper High: Note the position of the familiar group constituting the big dipper. These seven stars of medium brightness are now high in the north-west and are circling downward toward the north. The dipper stars mixture inside the tier and drops it into deep, hot fat for frying.
