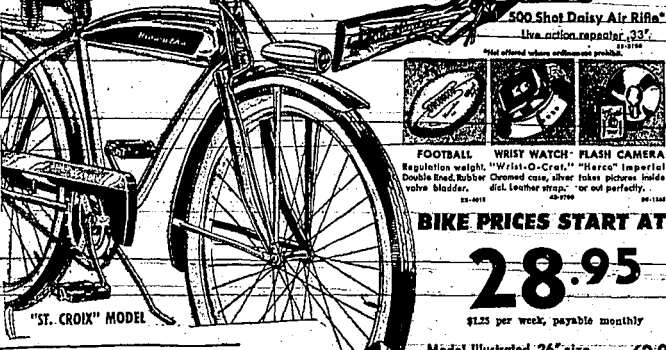

Smith said the subject never was discussed, however.

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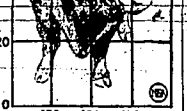

### 75 Present at Church Event

WASHINGTON, Aug. 5 (AP)—President Eisenhower's expected to give prompt approval to legislation to plug a tax loophole.

The bill was whipped through congress in the final run for adjournment. Both the senate and house approved it by voice vote.

Under present tax law, persons who remain outside the United States for 17-out-of-18 consecutive months are not subject to federal income taxes.

However, complaints have poured in that movie stars and businessmen have "vanish" mysteriously abroad and lived outside the country in order to escape payment of income taxes.

The bill provides that only \$20,000 of annual income would be tax exempt under the section. The house originally has voted to keep the controversial feature entirely, but bowed to the senate version.

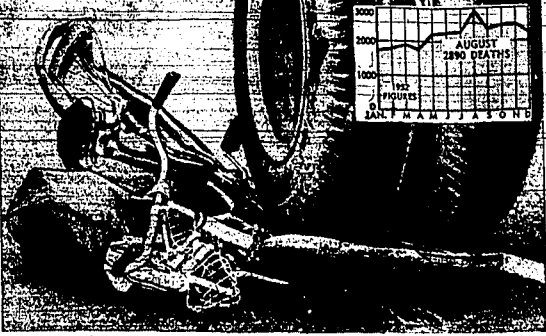

August is the year's worst traffic month, according to the National Safety Council, and it will pay both motorists and drivers to be extra careful. This photo was taken in West Bend, Wis., after a truck ran over a child riding a bicycle. Insert shows highway deaths by months for 1952, which reached their peak in August with 2,890 deaths. This was 28 per cent higher than the average 1952 month. And for every traffic fatality there were 25 injuries. Main reason for the increase is that more cars than usual travel the highways during August, but another factor is what the National Safety Council calls the "reaction altitude."

## U. S. Food Aid for East Reich Hits Communists in Soft Spot

When the United States introduced "operation food" for East Germany the communists promptly howled, and said it was a sign of interfering with the real objective of the allies should reopen normal trade channels and let the Russian zone buy what it needs. 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## Testimony of Seattle Firm Draws Blast

WASHINGTON, Aug. 5 — Four-line testimony on behalf of the Seattle Gas company was pronounced Tuesday after a power commission examiner said he would disallow a motion to strike portions of company exhibits unless they were substantiated by a financial report. Seattle is one of several distributing companies now giving market testimony before the commission in connection with rival applications by three pipeline companies to serve the Pacific northwest with natural gas.

Offers Witnesses Attorney Arthur Palmer, concluding Seattle presentations, said he would offer both a policy and financial witness when the company's presentation is cross-examined. The offer prompted Examiner Glen R. Law to remark that he did not know whether a policy witness would be required but "unless you offer a financial witness I will entertain a motion to strike portions of your exhibits."

City Return Claim He referred specifically to a page in which the company forecast a 6.4 per cent return on its investment in the first year of natural gas service. The rate of return was shown to increase to 7.7 per cent in the third year to drop to 7.5 in the fourth and fifth years. Law said Seattle's only witness so far, Assistant Gen. Mr. Leland Jones, had not substantiated this part of the forecast.
