NEW HOPE FOR BRITAIN

There is so much disheartening news from abroad that it is pleasant to be able to find a bright ray on the horizon. This shatt of light comes from Great Britain, where a substantial economic upturn is in progress.

substantial economic upturn is in progress. According to reports, Britain's improvement is founded largely on an elemental fact of trade: the prices of the raw materials and some of the other things it buys have gone down, while prices on the products it exports have held steady. This has fattened the British bank account, building up gold and dollar reservers.

The wo flush of health redounds to the benefit of the ruling Conservative party, which has been in the saddle since the fail of 1951. No one pretends that the Conservatives have any pish-button command of world material prices; that much is just their good fortune. But even Labor party men privately concede Conservative-leaders have done a good job.

The Conservatives have done considerable toward stimulating a fresh surge of free activity. They have denationalized the steel and trucking industries, and wiped out many another burdensome control. They have an inped at the British elitizer's crushing tax load. They have taken a big stride toward. And they have established somewhat better labor-management relations—as measured

This recovery, plus the greatly enhanced sition of the Conservative party, stands in position of the Conservative party, stands in-nharp contrast to the situation that prevailed in the first months after Sir Winston Church-ill's return to power. Then the Conservatives were glum-faced before problems that seemed well nigh hopeless; and the voters appeared disenchanted with their new leaders.

appeared disenchanted with their new leaders.

In this low, steady, upward haul there is encouragement for the Eisenhower administration, another middle-of-the-road government which is trying to demonstrate that economy and good management are possible even in these chaotic days.

In Britain, the debionstration could not be made in the first six months or even the first year. But eventually a mark was made, Looking agroes at this example, most fair-minded Americans may be more than ever disposed to give Fresident Eisenhower reasonable time to show that there is more than one way to run a government.

OUR INTERFERENCE RESENTED

The big problem of battling communism western Europe has been to convince the orking people of those countries that Ameran-style capitalism and the free enterprise stem have more to offer them than commism or socialism.

munism or socialism.

Fair progress in this phase of the battle for men's minds has been reported from West Germany. The people there can set inter-thind that communism offers the East Germans only a hollow shell.

In France and Italy, however, the fact that the free enterprise way of life offers a higher, standard of living to the working people has not registered. Communism still seems to promise more to more people.

This is one of the underlying reasons for the setback which the de Gasperl govern-ment suffered in Italy's last elections and for the more recent strike wave in France. The people there simply do not have confidence that their government and their-employers are not at all interested in giving them a better break.

better break.

Beginning with the Marshall plan, the United States has tried hard to sell this idea of greater profit sharing to the Europeans, and to the rest of the world for that matter. American businessmen have tried to sell it to European businessmen and American let bor leaders have tried to sell it to European businessmen and American let bor leaders. It has been known generally as the "productivity drive." But the tidea has not caught on and has been slowed to a walk.

President Eisenhower's report to congress on the first six months of foreign aid opera-tions in his administration brushes off this productivity drive with a scant five para-

graphs. Matter of fact, all the initiative in the productivity drive has now been turned over to the Europeans. It has been practically abundanced as an American enterprise.—

At temendous cost, that European businessmen don't want American productivity methods introduced in their factories. They actually resent American interference.
