Hunter Demonstrates Method for Hanging Deer or Elk

The loop at the bottom of the rope is turned under the gambrel (the cross-stroke lodged in the rear legs of the animal) and a lever stick is placed across the gambrel and hooked into the end of the loop. Hunter Relates Method for Hoisting Big Game to Tree

For the hunter who bags big game and faces the problem of strapping his animal up to a tree without block and tackle, Fred Rudolph, Twin Falls, has the answer.

According to Rudolph's method, the hunter need carry only a good stick, a rope and a gambrel, and three strong sticks.

One stick, two and one-half inches in diameter, serves as a gambrel and is notched in the hind legs of the animal.

Along both ends of the rope are tied the sturdy tree limb from which the deer or elk is to be suspended. The loop hanging below the animal's hind legs is about 18 inches above the ground.

The loop is drawn around the gambrel. The second stick, serving as a lever, is laid across the gambrel and hooked in the tip of the loop.

As the lever is wound around the gambrel the animal is hoisted toward the limb.

When the animal has been elevated to the desired height, the third stick is inserted between the lever and the two strands of rope coming down from the limb to keep the lever and rope from unwinding, Rudolph explained.

Rudolph said he has been using the method for four or five seasons, and has demonstrated it to more than 100 hunters. He said he had met only one hunter during those years who was familiar with the method.

He suggested that hunters using the method wait until the animal is strung up before spilling the bracket. He said the rear legs are more easily held together while the deer is being placed on the gambrel if the bracket remains intact.

5 Men Report on Cave Exploration

SALT LAKE CITY, Oct. 5 (UP)—Five adventures workers their way several hundred feet inside dangerous Neff canyon cave in Utah's Wasatch mountains then ended their exploration Sunday night because of exhaustion.

Dr. William R. Hamilton, 47, led the group which spent 33 hours in the unexplored cavern. He said his plunger indicated that the cave was about 400 feet deep with almost perpendicular walls.

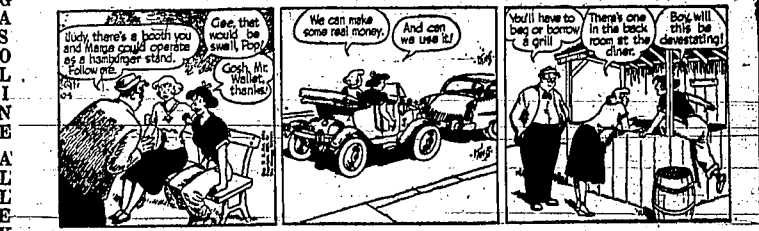

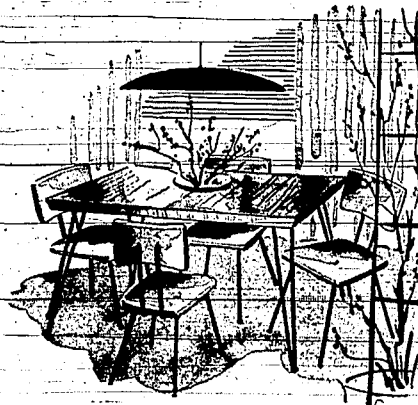

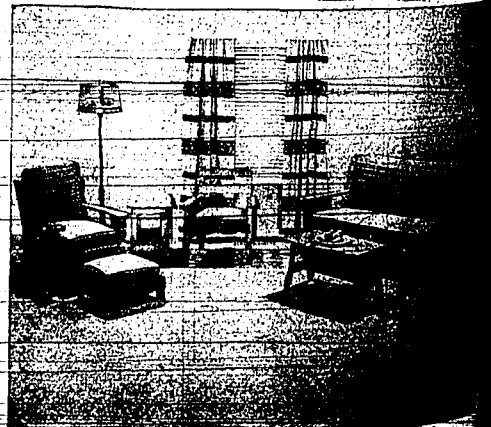
