

U. S. 93 PERRING OF Now that U. S. 93 is becoming a major north and south transcontinental highway, it is fulfilling a dream which the Four States Highway association has had for many years.

For a long, long time it was difficult to get public officials and the states traversed by this particular highway much interested in this possibilities of U. S. 93.
