- Produce approximately the same amount of power "at site" and downstream as the proposed single federal dam. Any small difference in output which might for a relatively short period, and under certain temporary committees, favor the single dam would be prohibitively expensive.
- Make possible the production of over 40 billion kilo-watt hours—the carput of Bonnerille Dam (or approx-mately 10 years—prior to the time a single high dam could be completed.
- Provide 1,000,000 acre feet of storage, the maximum dependable amount afforded at the site after taking into account the future upstream irrigation development, and resulting-depletion of water available for power storage purposes.
