SPECULATION ABOUT 1956

A fair number of columnists and others already are "retiring" President Elsenhower at the end of his first term. With the President just nine months into his job, their conclusions are a trifle premature.

The reports about Mr. Elsenhower's alleged attitude are many and varied. Some asy he made up his mind before he ever got into presidential politics, that he would serve only four years. Others say this conviction has developed since he entered the White House. He is said to have no liking for the job, and to wish to escape at the earliest channel. He is said to be annoyed by criticism, and to find the hard fightling with members of conjersed distanctiful. There is even one account which says he shows fatigue easily and becomes irritated with his staff.

things are true, which could well be an unwarranted assumption, there is no reason to
take these comments too actiously now.

Such an operation, when first encountered, would almost surely have something of a shock, effect on a man like Mr. Eisenhower. He is a gentle, sensitive person, and at the same time is accustomed to the neatness and order of the military world. Yet the presidency defies neat bounds, and it is rough on human sensibilities.

This all adds up to a way of saying it is too early to speak so positively about what the Steahnewer will do in 1985. Pra-While House declarations and first job reactions are the sure tool of future presidential behavior. Not only do men's attitudes change, but they cannot possibly forcesse all the circumstances which will enter into the decision when they finally must determine whether or not to run again.

With great advance fanfare, a Big Three meeting was slated last summer for Bermuda. It had to be postponed first because the French had no premier, and then because Prime Minister-Churchill fell ill.

As a gathering of heads of state, it is not now likely to be reinstand, even though Sir Winston appears to have largely recovered. But there can be little doubt that the meeting of the British, French and American foreign ministers in London was planned as something of a substitute,


