



NEW DEFENSE IDEA

Behind all the present argument over the size of future U. S. defense budgets there is an as yet unanswered question for foreign

all as yet unanswered question for foreign policy.

How does the United States propose to check aggression in any part of the world? Will it have to be done by the now old fashioned conventional weapons of World war II, as in Knera? Or can it be done cheaper by atomic and hydrogen bombs?

At first glance it might seem that this was a purely military question to be decided by the department of defense. But it goes much higher. The decision to use or not to use the atomic bomb is reserved by law to the President of the United States. The policy has been not to use the bomb.

This applied to Korea. It applies to the dighting in Indo-China. It would presumably apply if fighting were to break out in any other trouble spot.

other trouble spot.

It is now argued in some quarters that it the United States had a clear policy statement that it would henceforth use atomic weapons to put down acts of aggression, they wouldn't happen.

The implications of such a policy present a frightening responsibility. If atomic bombs were to be used to stop the war in Inde-China, or to stop renewed hostilities in Korea, they would have to be dropped on communits sources of supply. These are obviously bases in China, in Manchuria and even in Russia.

Russia.

What such action would lead to is a matter for debate. While it might stop local aggression momentarily, it would probably enlarge any war. No world leader would want to take on the responsibility for this action lightly.

Two things-have happened, however, to bring this issue to a head, One is the tremendous advance that has been made to

Two things-have happened, however, to bring this issue to a head, One is the tremendous advance that has been made in atomic weapon development and in the stockpiling over the past two years. The other is the terrific cost to the United States in trying to maintain armed forces prepared to fight both conventional and atomic wars.

In the new frantic efforts to reduce the cost of national defense and out taxes, something is going to have to give. Advocates of greater use of an atomic threat argue the only way this economy can be effected is to out more relisance on the bomb and new weapons still under development.

*One of the main arguments for this new concept is that U. S. armed forces are now to widely dispersed. Too many divisions are in Europe, too many in Korea, Japan-and-other Pacific bases. Naval forces are in the far east; European waters and the Mediter-

of Asis.

The only prospects for contracting or reducing these forces is through building up the defenses of countries like Germany and Japan. Agreement from France to go ahead with the European defense community idea would help mightly. But such rearmament is still several years away.

An alternative; and this is obviously an air force proposal, is the maintenance of a chain of air bases in strategic locations like Okinawa and Spain. These bases would be kept in serviceable condition, ready to receive heavy reinforcements the instant trouble abstract and a characteristics.

This is admittedly a concept of a national defense policy based on warfare of the future. Its reliance on the mere threat of atomic mesapons to prevent wars is questioned by many experienced military experts. They recall that "victory through air power alone" did not work in either World war II or in Korea. They insist that conventional armaments will always be necessary.

To the believers in the offectiveness of

ments will always be necessary.

To the belivers in the effectiveness of policing the world with atomic weapons, the idea of planning for four-year wars is obsolete thinking. They insist that wars could be won in 30 days and at perhaps one-thousandth of the cost of wars fought in the first half of the twentieth century with conventional weapons.

The economy of abonic preparedness represents some of the changed thinking in Washington. Up to now the idea has been that abonic armament would always be an added and extra burdensome, but unavoidable, cost in future wars.
