





Few men of independent mind and split will quarted with the proposition that Sir Winston Churchill, the British prime minister, is a great man.
Fewer still will deny that he is a great writer and speechmaker.
The Nobel price he recently won was merety the most spectacular formal acknowleds—ment of his writing talents.
He has always possessed the supreine gift of being able to catch in a single phrase the meaning of a time or a cause, or a man. His belligerent words of deflance were worth many divisions to the British and the whole free world—after France fell in World war. It. His phrase, the "iron curtish," provided the perfect symbol for the almost impenational properties of the property of the proper

tratic parrier separating east and west in the postwar era. Now Churchill, nearing 79 and perhaps in his last months as active leader of Britain, has completed the sixth and final volume of his personal history of World war II. The entre series is hailed as a brilliant contribution


