No matter how often we hear of atrocities, we can never become steeled against them. It is always a great shock when they are revealed anew.

We ought to know by now that atrocities are second nature to communists, as they were to mails, and perhaps in some degree to ell tyrants.

to all tyrants.

The army says 5,113 U. S. servicemen were murdered, tortured to death, stayred or subjected to other bestlail treatment by the commists for in Korea. Allogether the reds did away with 11,622 military victims in this fashion, and 17,354 civilians, mostly North and South Koreans.

Many of these selections.

Many of these crimes were perpetrated by men who were gripped by fanatical hatred of non-asiatics. But many more will stand as frightful evidence of the cold contempt felt by communists for their fellow humans, of whatever color or creed or nation.

To the communists, it mattered little whether these people did on the march, or later on in some fillsy prison camp. One thing was aware: Their prime interest was not in Keeping them alive but in helping them to die.

them to dis.

To promote this end, the reds have made a calculated science of their finhumanity to man. They are still refining their diabolical techniques.

Recniques.

In the recently suspended war, they let bitter cold, exhaustion, filthy, inadequate food and rampant disease work their ravages upon the weak. For the strong, they reserved

upon the weak, For one strong, says account more strenuous tortures.
Often bayonets were used as instruments of alow death, We have one photograph showing a man being subjected to fiendish torture with a pointed bamboo stick. Clubbings and other beatings were too common for command.

These devices of cruel death are the contrivances of beings who do not deserve the label "human." They have minds superficially resembling those of other men, yet they do not employ them as other men do. They reject human values. They caralt the ways of the beast. Like animals, they are quite content to leave the torn bodies of their competitors to rot in the fields and forests.

The army says it has enough evidence for war crimes trials in only 34 cases. The pictorial record, however, is thoroughly damning, and it ought to be spread across the globe.

Idaho Power Company's Plan **Fully Protects Irrigation**

Rights --- Present and Future

Witnesses before the Federal Power Commission by careful estimates determined that approximately 1,200,000 acres of new land would be reclaimed by irrigation in the area above the Hells Canyon stretch of the Snake River in the period

This means that, year by year, more and more water must be reserved for irrigation, and less will be available for power and other purposes.

Accordingly, Idaho Power's plans for its Hells Canyon area development provide for use of only as much water as will be available after the needs of irrigation have been met.

The proposed federal dam, with its contemplated storage capacity of 3,800,000 acre feet, would either stand partially empty in low water years, or water to fill it would have to be taken away from the needs of irrigation.

In southern Idaho and eastern Oregon, the use of water for irrigating farms has always come ahead of the use of water for electric power - for agriculture is the Snake River Valley's most im-

Here is the provision protecting irrigation rights written into water permit applications made by Idaho Power Company to the State of Idaho for the Hells Canyon area projects:

"The rights herein granted for the use of the waters . . . are subject to the conditions that the project shall be operated in such manner as will not conflict with the future depletion and flow of the waters of Snake River and its tributaries, or prevent or interfere with the future upstream diversion and use of such water for the irrigation of lands and other beneficial consumptive uses in the Snake River watershed."

Idaho Power's Program in Summary

The Company's program will-

- Fully develop the Hells Canyon stretch of the Snake River at a far lower construction cost—and at a far lower cost of producing power than any other plan.
- Produce approximately the same amount of power "at alte" and downstream as the proposed single federal dam. Any small difference in output which might for a relatively short period and under certain temporary conditions favor the single dam would be prohibitively exponsive.
- 3 Make possible the production of over 40 billion kilo-watt hours—the output of Bonneville Dam for ap-proximately 10 year—prior to the time a single high dam could be completed.
- Provide 1,000,000 acre feet of storage—the maximum dependable amount afforded at the site after taking into account the future upstream irrigation development and resulting depletion of water available for power atorage purposes.

- Fully provide the release of water required by the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers for navigation
- Adequately meet the test of flood-control needs.
- Create a superior recreational area.
- Fully protect irrigation water rights of present and future agricultural development upstream. (There is no irrigation to be served from a reservoir at this site
- Provide large blocks of low-cost power rapidly, to serve the needs of Snake River Valley and of the Pa-cific Northwest through inter-connection with the Northwest Process Paris
- Be productive of \$10,000,000 annually in tax revo-nues for federal, state and local taxing units in addinues for federal, state and local taxing units in addition to the tax revenues created by users of the power-all without cost to taxpayers.
