





EISENHOWER'S HUMILITY

Although the word "humility" has been abused in a good many instances, it is a term that will applie to President Eisenhower whenqued in a serious vein.

When, as General Eisenhower, he made a great reputation as a solidier-diplomat, it was not widely realized how humble a man he is. Humility is not a quality automatically called to mind as one thinks of a world leader, particularly a high military commander.

Yet, for the kind of inspiring leadership he was exerting among the free nations, both as wartime chief and later as NATO commander, Mr. Eisenhower's humility was no handicap. It served rather to endear him to our allies and to strengthen his influence as a leader of men.

It was in character that he should not

Rews in character that he should not wish to seek the presidency. He could not wish to seek the presidency. He could not however, indefinitely turn adde the pressures upon him to make himself "systilable." With obvious rathustane, he yielded in 1953.

And so he became President, and brought with him to the White House that same humility its existence proved a shock to many people who had not looked a thin classify until then. They perhaps imagined him equipped with the kind of ego that makes some leaders ride roughshod over their opponents.

Mr. Elsenhower does not have it. He is a composer of differences, an accommodator, Being that, he has brought much that is new and refreshing in presidential attitude. He has tried to see all sides, to be President of all the people. He has sought to avoid humiliating or crushing anyone.

Suil, this admirable trait has its unhappy aspect for a man occupying the White House, for in that place he is more than the leader of his country. He is the chief of his power which he can wield not only-for partisan advantage but also for the larger good, in other words, the party-machinery, properly managed, can, function as a zort of booster for the more cumbersome machinery of government.

Being not merely humble but green in politics, the President has tried to shirk from this part of his job. He has made political decisions only when they were forced upon him. This often has left him at the mercy of competing advice, with the result that he has seemed to "back and fill" as pressures shifted.
