Having captured the vacant seat in the California 3th congressional district, the Republicans are breathing easier. They took only one of the three seats put on the block this fail, but they feel one is better than none. The winner, by 8,300 votes, was Olenard Lipscomb, who had been associated with Vice President Nixon in his 1952 campaign. He won the seat formerly held by a Republican, Norris Poulson, who resigned to become mayor of Los Angeles.

On paper the GOP actually seemed to have more to worry about in this California district than in the Wisconsin and New Jersey distrigts they lost.

For there were two Republican and two Democratic candidates in the race, and the fear was that Lipscomb's rival would seriously divide the GOP vote. On the other hand, it was felt that George Arnold, the chief Democratip prospect, would not have real composition.

In the old days they could tell within a vote or two how some. See precincts would go, Now they're lucky if they guess the winner.

PAINTING PROBLEMS

The present fad for "Do-21-Yourself" home repairs has resulted in a new business market with a sales potential of 875 a year for every house in the United States. Of this amount, \$50 is spent for lumber, according to reports made at the Washington meeting of the National Lumber Manufacturers' association.

One problem which the lumbermen are investigating is how to reduce the costs of painting woodwork. To avoid this cost, and high lumber costs, many homebuilders are turning to brick and other materials.

Detail painting around doors and windows accounts for 60 per cent of house painting costs. Licking this problem, the lumbermen proported, would help them recapture part of the market now lost to metal doors and window sashes.



















