Two events gave the pinn its finn above, one was the most recent Russian note on the subject. While that message did not apositically decline the western invitation, neither did it accept, Bowtet allence was interpreted in western capitals as pretty conclusive evidence capitals as pretty conclusive evidence.

The second happening was Prime Minister Churchill's recognition of the present hope-lessness of the conference altuntion: Since it was he who first broached the idea force-fully on May 11, his acknowledgment at parliament's opening that it was now probably unwise was a decisive turn.

When Stalin died on March 6, observers of the Sowiet union felt his successors would thereafter be prochocipled for long months, perhaps years, with consolidating their perhaps believed Russia might be in a mood to accept a breathing spell internationally.

It was in that spirit of curiodity about Russia's world intenpions that Sir Winston reposes do not proposed a four-power pariety. Western leaders narrowed the possible agends to Germany and Austria to keep the conference within reasonable bounds and provide a test of Russians sincerty.

The United States never had enthusiasm for the plan, believing the Russians should evidence sincerity by major acts of conciliation before anyone ought to sit with them at the conference stable. Rehutantly, our government agreed to a four-power meeting at

the conference table, keluciantly, our gov-nment agreed to a four-power meeting at a foreign-ministers' level. Churchill wanted a heads of state to meet.

the heads of state to meet.

But in the subsequent months Russia has rebuifed every invitation, no matter how phrased. It is plain today, to all but the most subborn neutralists in France and Britain, that the Soviet union does not want a conference and has no present intention of negotiating seriously issues like German unity and an Austrian peace treaty.

The guess that the Kreihlin might be minded to ease substantially some major points of tension with the west appears to be lil-founded. The Russians seem more set upon holding the west at ram's length while they consolidate power and appease restive

they consolidate power and appease restive domestic populations at home and in the

satellittes.

In fact, recent Soviet statements in Moscow and in the U. N. sound more and more like the old, tough Stalin policy. We cannot know yet why this is so. But we do realize that it holds no great hope for the west.

Our diplomats still are keeping the door open. But they do not seriously believe that any Russian is likely soon to walk through it.

PHILIPPINE ELECTION

The United States government is bound to be pleased at the recent sweeping victory of 46-year-old Ramon Magsaysay in the Philip-pine presidential election.

Despite Quirino's charges of "American interference" in the election, this country die nothing official to affect the campaign. Nev-ertheless, its tacit support was with the

winner, Magaaya's smashing triumph certainly must be rigarded at least parily as a tribute to him as a national here. It was he who shead of national defense under Quirino, successfully crushed the communist-insped Huk rebels who had so long troubled the tribunds.

Because of this alone, his victory was widely forceast. How much this verdict stands also as a rebuke to Quirino is something to be settled only by the searching scrutiny of the voting results which will come with time. Magsayany charged throughout his campaign that Quirino's regime was shot through with graft and corruption, that high officials and their relatives had lined their pockets well during his terure in office. He declared also that Quirino's had been lax in pushing for new schools, roads, agricultural and other reforms.

The president denied corruption and cited a number of industrial and public projects, admittedly helped by American aid, as proof his regime was progressive.

Possibly the voters were influenced by two special factors affecting Quirino. One was special factors and age. He is 33, and so alling he had a doctor and nurse in tow at all times during the campaign.

The other fact is that under the Philippine constitution, he could have served only two more years, since he has already served eight and there is a 10-year limit. His vice presidential running mate would have succeeded him after two years.

U. S. officials presumably feel that Magnessy with This powerfurt hold on the propie, will assure the Philippines of a more stable government in the years shead. His record almost guarantees he will be a stout foe of communism, a vital requirement in the vulnerable orient.

All saide from the outcome, this election must be viewed as heartening to the entire free world. It was a demonstration of real democracy at work on the far east, a quarter of the globe sorely in need of such a practical display of the meaning of freedom.




