

One can't help hoping that former President Truman has not made his final presentation for the record in the Harry Dexter White case.

dent Truman has not made his limal presentation for the record in the Harry Dexicr White case.

For one thing, in his speech of explanation, which partook of the old "whistle-slop" flavor in its more vehement passages, he said a good many things about his handling of the case. Since then, Altorney General Brownell and Fill Chief Edgar Hoover have contradicted him on major points.

2. When, exactly, did he read the second FBT report, delivered to the White House on Feb. 4, 1946? He says he "Wist learned" of the charges against White "early in February." Idd he read the report promptly, or wast day or so?

3. If he did read it shortly after receipt, wh

charges against While "early in February."
Did he read the report promptly, or wall a diay or so?

3. If he did read it shortly after receipt, why did he not take the quick, precautionary step of telling senate leaders to hold up White's confirmation to a new government post? That would have given him time to study the problem leisurely and thoroughly.

4. Why did Mr. Truman imply so strongly that the later state of the research had supported his decision to retain White?

Mr. Truman waxed indigenant that Brownell seemed to be indirectly assailing a deal of the research of the resear

tion through the hands of White and other suspects?

6. Hoover said Mr. Truman wanted White surrounded by safe people. Why, then, did he not interpose objection when two prime suspects were named to the international monetary fund where White was operating?

7. Did the former President believe no real case could be made against White as a security risk unless he could be indicted in a court of law? At many points Mr. Truman sounds as if he thought White had to be left alone until he was caught red-handed.

8. Did Mr. Truman have any feeling that even if the charges were true, it didn't really matter, since. Russia had been our wartime ally, and, was still. "Iriendly?" He seems to have come slowly to the idea there might be any real peril in the 'reported passing of secret information to the Soviet union.


