

One day this last week there appeared in the Times-News and many newspapers throughout the country, a cartoon portraying a great change which has come about in this country—a change we ahould all recognize and give serious thought.

In fact, we have heard some comment about this cartoon locally, and in one place of busi-ness at least, we noticed it posted on a bulle-tin board.

The cartoon contrasted the American farm The cartoon contrasted the American farmer as of yesterday and today. In times gone by, he represented a great and powerful force, and in this cartoon he was quoted as saying to the politician in no uncertain terms: "Now look! I'm the world's most independent person, see. I'm the original rugged individualist! I vote as I please and I ask no quarter from amphody—least of all from you—so scram!"

Then, by contrast, the cartoon portrayed 'too many farmers' as a weak, little individual of today, speaking to a monatrous politician. Instead of asserting his independenche whimpered to the politician as a follows: If you want my vote yin gotta subsidies me!"

'If yuh want my vote yuh gotta subsidize mei

he whimpered to the politician as follows:

"If you want my votey in potta subsidize mei"

Let no American, in any walk of life, think for a minute that this loss of independence has been, suffered only by the farmers. Directly or indirectly, this great compromise with a solicitous federal bureaucracy has and is affecting every last one of us.

No longer are we a majority of determined individualists with confidence in our own initiative and abilities. The minute the cattle market starts going haywire, the price of spuds falls into a siump, or somagné suggests the need for a new public building, the ery goes out for federal aid, leans, supports, subsidies, or outright gifts of some sort.

Too many of us have lost sight of the fact that the government, in granting us all these handouts, is only spending money it exacted from us through taxation in the first place. The money that remains, that is, after the bureaucrats have taken their divey to maintain their sprawling payrolis.

Too many Americans are either kidding themselves or are guillible to the point of stapidity in thinking that the "other fellow" is paying for all the benefits they receive—these loans, subsidies, supports, grants and what not, which the government and the politicians have made so popular.

Of course, there are those exceptional stal-warts who still demand the right to paddie-their own cances, and who derive real satisfaction, as did the early ploneers, in demonstrating their own personal courage, initiative, individualism and independence. They are still the backbone of this country, believe it or not, because of their refusal to accept to root, because of their refusal to accept the server government handout that is made available.

What those who coloy riding the gravy train do not yet realize, perhaps, is that the greatest internal danger to the economic growth of this country at the present time is the accelerated treng of the pass 10 years cloward government-guaranteed, security—an ever magnified reliance by individual clikens upon the government-a attitude of dependence rather than independence.
